What a year 2009 was at the Taubenheim Ranch. Great grass along with powerful mothers led to a very growthy set of bulls. There will be a vast amount of balancers offered as well as some top of the line purebreds. The genetics being offered are tremendous, with many pedigrees for great outcross genetics. A large portion of the offering are by A.I. sires giving you, the cattlemen, a great opportunity to increase many traits in your cowherds.

The offering is 100% polled, with nearly 50 Homozygous black bulls to choose from. Feel free to stop by and view the bulls at your convenience—there will always be someone at the farm to assist you.

Once again we will be exhibiting a pen of balancer bulls at the National Western Stock Show in Denver. The kids will also be showing on the hill. If you come down to Denver, feel free to stop by the stalls and check out the livestock; and if you're lucky we might even be grilling on one of Jeannette's Traeger grills.
